

# EBTA Summer Camp 2016

**What** EBTA International Task-group (ICT) is organizing a Summer Camp, where some senior SFBT practitioners will share their professional know-how with younger practitioners, who want to promote solution-focused thinking and practices in their work settings and beyond.



**Why** Some younger practitioners expressed during the Vienna conference 2015 their hope that EBTA would promote ways for the older SF generation EBTA to be mentors for them. A Summer Camp offers a good way to do this in a relaxed atmosphere and place with enough time to reflect and share.

**When** July 3rd to 7<sup>th</sup> 2016

**Where** Jakob-Ramsjö island is 60 km west of Helsinki. Peter Sundman's simple summer residence has 8 beds in 4 rooms. Tents will be provided for part of the group.

**Who** The mentors are Peter Sundman, Ursula Buehlmann, John Wheeler and Ferdinand Wolf.

**For** 4-8 SF practitioners who promote solution-focused thinking and practices in their area and want to learn more from the mentors and are willing to contribute something to EBTA in the future.

**Doing** Informal discussions of topics of interest, sharing SF know-how, working on materials, imagining the future in between cooking, chopping wood, eating, sauna and enjoying the midnight sun.

**Costs** Personal travel costs to and from the village Inkoo nearby and a share of the food and drinks. There is a daily public bus transport to and from Helsinki.
